Official Rules of Sole Soccer at Brecknock County Park

Basic rules:

1. Everyone plays.
2. Scoring is the object but is not mandatory.
3. Basic skills should be applied during games.
4. All play stops when coach gets the ball.
5. Assistant coach or parents should assist when available.
6. Shin guards and cleats may be worn but are not necessary.
