### **Kent County Parks and Recreation 2019 Earth Day Activities at Hunn Nature Park**

On Saturday, April 20 starting at 9 a.m., volunteers will be planting a limited amount of replacement trees, mulching trees, resurfacing trails and picking up litter at the Hunn Nature Park, 1624 Sorghum Mill Road, Dover .

There will be something for all ages and abilities to do. Bring leather work gloves, hard-soled, lace-up shoes or boots, a round-point shovel and a garden rake if you have one, as the County only has a limited quantity of rakes and shovels on site. Also, be sure to dress appropriately for outdoor work and the weather.

If you wish to be an “Adult Team Leader” and you’re over 18 years-old, you will be required to register in advance and attend a lunch-time “Safety Training” the day before the event (Friday, April 19) at 11:30 a.m. at the site. Pizza and beverages will be provided by Kent County. Volunteers will be assigned to Team Leaders on the day of the event.
