Kent County employees are asked to roll up their sleeves and support the community by participating in the annual blood drive for the Blood Bank of Delmarva scheduled for **Thursday, September 20, 2019** from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. in Room 220 of the Kent County Administrative Complex. There is a minimum of 20 participants required to have an on-site drive, so please make sure to sign up by the September 13, 2019 deadline.



It takes at least 350 donors per day to supply the 19 local hospitals throughout the Delmarva Peninsula with the blood they need for patients. And in order to maintain a safe blood supply, a seven-day inventory of all blood types must be continually replenished.

Giving one hour of your time can help save a life in your community. So many people can be assisted with your gift of time and blood. About one in seven hospital admissions requires a blood transfusion. Those in need include cancer patients, accident, burn, or trauma victims, newborn babies and their mothers, transplant recipients, surgery patients, and many more.

The blood drive provides an opportunity for every County employee to have a positive impact locally.
